Along the exposition, the visitors can also admire various machines: a corn husker, lever scales, bottling machines, wine kegs and veterinary utensils that are no longer used. Furthermore, there is a collection of coins pertaining to the Italian Kingdom and Republic and another concerning some old toys. A quite interesting item in the collection is a remarkable series of local measures for solids which were abolished after the introduction of the decimal system during Napoleonic power, but which were still used in the countryside until some decades ago.

On the walls, pictures dating back to the 1930s and 40s, show the different steps of rural activities: plowing, sowing and threshing. There are also some very old postcards of Castel San Giovanni.
